Introduction

The Dorenell Community Benefit Fund provides for a microgrant scheme, under which Dufftown and District Community Association receives an annual amount to make grants of up to £1000 to groups or individuals for charitable activities within the Dufftown & District area.

On April 2nd 2020, Dufftown and District Community Association received its first tranche of £11,321.18 to distribute through the microgrant fund.

Individuals and groups can apply to the fund by submitting an application form, stating the details and benefit of proposed activity.

Decisions on grant awards are made by the Dufftown and District Community Association Board of Trustees. There is no set application deadline. Grant applications are reviewed at monthly Board meetings.

Between April 2020 and November 2022, £10,156.15 was awarded through the Dufftown & District microgrant fund.

About us

Dufftown and District Community Association is a registered charity (SC023622). Our charitable purposes are:

- To relieve the poverty of the local population of Dufftown and District.
- To advance the education of the local population of Dufftown and District.
- To provide, fundraise, manage or assist in the provision of facilities and/or activities in the interest of social welfare for recreation/leisure.

Community Events

Impact

Young people and sports

Dufftown Football Club received a grant to purchase equipment and deliver a football summer camp for local youngsters which was to run from the 8th to 12th of August 2022. 22 young people (aged 7-16 years old) expressed an interest with 20 of them participating over the course of the week. In five days they achieved a combined total of 7080 minutes of activity in glorious weather.




Comments from parents:

Impact

Outdoor environment

Visitors to Dufftown and volunteers at the Keith and Dufftown Railway can now use the new bike racks to keep their bikes safe whilst exploring the heritage rail station.





Garden upgrades

Using the Dufftown & District microgrant, Aigan court sheltered housing will improve their front garden to make it easier for the residents to access the water tap for watering the plants.

Town centre flowers

Dufftown in Bloom received a microgrant to purchase plants and compost for their baskets and flower beds that brighten up Dufftown throughout the summer months.

Marketing and Communications

During its first round, the Dufftown & District microgrant fund was promoted to the local community through social media posts. Local groups and individuals were encouraged to get in touch with Dufftown and District Community Association to discuss their project and receive a microgrant application to submit.

To increase awareness of the fund and make the application process easier, Dufftown and District Community Association made the microgrant application available online on the Dufftown community website in November 2022.

In the future, the Dufftown & District microgrant scheme will be regularly promoted on the Dufftown and District Community Association social media as well as local funding guides, such as tsiMoray monthly newsletters.

Conclusion

The first tranche of Dorenell Wind Farm Benefit Fund microgrants delivered through Dufftown and District Community Association has brought several benefits to the community. Awards made since the beginning of the fund are already having a positive impact through community events, new equipment and sports activities.
